My name is Gloria Grening Wolk. I am a resident of Raleigh, North Carolina, and have been over the age of eighteen for decades. I am responsible for the pleadings filed by young Mr. Farris.

My introduction to legal research and writing was the certificate program, "Social Work and the Law," offered at the graduate school where I received the Master's degree in Social Work. In recent years, having read a great deal of law and about wrongful convictions, I offered research and writing services to a number of innocence groups. That is how Timothy Michael Farris and I became acquainted—a referral.

I am not a lawyer but I admit to being a ghost researcher and ghost writer—actions most lawyers and judges find deplorable—because the results of my work are irrefutable evidence of the failures of defense counsel.

Mr. Farris' affidavit describes the hell his life has become since being arrested. What he does not know—and will not know until I mail this to him—is that people on the sex offender registry are targeted by serial killers (see attached). Recently, in Columbia, South

Carolina, two people were arrested after killing a man who was on the registry and the man's wife. They planned to kill others on the registry.

Although Mr. Farris is listed at many websites, along with his physical description, photo, and home address, the website for the Darlington sheriff's office also includes a description of his car and license plate number. He is at risk every day of his life, as is each family member.

Mr. Farris is innocent and has waited too long for justice. Every day prolongs the pain and the risk. His case was not added to the July-December 2013 docket, but it needs to be heard now, not in months, not next year. Once he is exonerated, he will be a productive, contributing member of society. Until then, he remains a victim.

I swear under penalty of perjury that every statement in this pleading is true.
